From the Pastor's Desk

"The Lord disciplines those whom he loves, and chastises every child whom he accepts." Endure trials for the sake of discipline. God is treating you as children; for what child is there whom a parent does not discipline? Hebrews 12: 6—7



I never liked these verses of scripture. They seemed punitive. As if God was an angry parent. Anytime someone quoted that verse to me, I would bristle. I didn't like the idea that bad things that happen to us are God's way of punishing us. I still don't buy that premise, but I realize now that my interpretation might have been incorrect. I figured this out only recently and I hope my new understanding of these verses will illuminate your path, as it did mine.

My back has been 'going out' with more frequency in the past few months. By that, I mean, I can be perfectly fine one minute and unable to move the next. You've all seen me hobble around when an episode takes place. Alarmed, I had an MRI taken and discovered I have 2 bulging and one herniated disc in my back. At the doctor's office, I was told that the back spasms that render me incapacitated are actually a GOOD thing! The spasms are the body's way of preventing me from doing further damage to my back. I must be immobile and these spasms ensure my compliance! The bad news is that these spasms will reoccur. The good news is that, with a disciplined approach to physical therapy and body mechanics, the spasms will not be as frequent or as severe.

I had an Epiphany in the doctor's office. I suddenly saw that the reason for the scriptural reference on discipline had nothing to do with punishment and everything to do with spiritual health. Just as my exercise program will strengthen the core muscles and mitigate the spasms, so the spiritual disciplines of prayer, meditation, scripture reading, worship, confession, will strengthen me for the difficulties of life. Those spiritual exercises, which at times feel tedious, are the tools which keep me strong when the inevitable illnesses, disappointments and grief overshadow my life. If I have been attending to those disciplines in the good times, then, when the pain comes, I have what I like to call a 'holy spine of steel' to support me.

I thank all those who are concerned about me when you see me hobbling around. But I hope it can also be an object lesson... enduring trials for the sake of discipline— and that we will all attend to those wonderful exercises God gives us to help us to endure!


