Board of World Missions News.....

Cuba - Christ's Spirit is active in the Moravian Church in Cuba. The first women's conference was held in Cuba Nov 30-Dec 2 in Havana, with about 60 women attending. The leadership is strong among the women in Cuba, who comprise the large majority of the membership there. Keep them in prayer as they join together to build up the women in their church.

Sierra Leone - The Luawa-Hiehun Community Moravian Church combines some of the best elements of our Moravian heritage (such as the right hand of fellowship in Holy Communion) with elements of the local culture--like the call to prayer by the drums at 6 a.m. each morning! They have a school lunch program (beans sent from the U.S., but now begun to be grown locally) with local greens and rice. They provide lunch for almost 200 students at the Moravian Secondary School. Please pray that their government will grant accreditation for additional levels of study (grades 10-12).
